# WHAT IS CARNIVAL RUNNING?



Pro running or “gift races” allow athletes of all ages and abilities to compete in a fun and competitive environment. Each athlete is given a mark, or handicap, based on their ability and competition history, giving them an equal opportunity to triumph in their chosen event.

Gifts are traditionally held on a grass surface and distances range from 70m – 3200m. There is prize money for each race and a winner’s sash for many events.

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## I’m registered with an Athletics Tasmania club, do I have to re-register?

If you’re already a registered member of Athletics Tasmania, then you are automatically registered with the Tasmanian Athletic League (TAL) and eligible to run at the carnivals.

## How old do you have to be to compete?

Athletes must have turned fourteen (14) years of age on the day of the carnival to compete in TAL races.
